1. Will he/she be happy at camp?
2. Will he/she be safe?
3. Will the counselor look after my child if they are sad or get hurt?
4. Will they make sure that they shower and brush their teeth?
5. Will he/she make new friends?
6. Will he/she get to bed on time?
7. Will he/she get enough to eat at meals? If he doesn't like something will they encourage him to try other foods?
8. Will he/she get their medicine at the scheduled time?
9. Will other kids pick on him/her because they weigh more or are not as good at sports?
10. Will he/she learn to be more independent and responsible in making choices and decisions?
11. Will my child's counselor be a good role model? (Appropriate language, behavior and dress?)
12. Will my child feel like their counselor really cares about them?
