



Registered Nurse – Dayshift

Position Purpose:

- The Clinic RN is responsible for delivery of health care and education to campers while assisting in the maintenance of smooth operations of the clinic.
- To ensure the health and safety of all campers.
- To provide a positive, enjoyable, supportive, and educational diabetes self-management learning environment for all campers.

Essential Job Functions:

- Reside on camp property for the committed session.
- Ensure the health and safety of all campers.
- Work regular shifts in the clinic.
- Participate in the general camp schedule of activities.

Nursing Tasks:

- Administer and document insulin and other medications.
- Assist with blood glucose checking as necessary.
- Assist campers during episodes of hypoglycemia.
- Document campers' blood glucose readings, insulin administration, insulin pump site changes, ketones, and hypoglycemia treatment.
- Ensure insulin pump basal rates and insulin ratio (carbohydrate and sensitivity) changed are inputted in the settings per MD orders.
- Assist with insulin pump site changes.
- Assist with insulin pump troubleshooting.
- Staff camper activities and provide medical support.
- Promptly respond and assist with camper and staff medical concerns or health emergencies including accidents, and high and low blood sugars. Treat or assist other medical staff with the treatment of moderate/severe hypoglycemia.
 - Follow protocols outlined in the Medical Manual.
 - Follow staff policies and procedures.
 - Flexibility to go where needed
 - coordination with HCM and provider on-call for general health needs and troubleshooting BG trends
 - participation with camp activities as appropriate to enhance the camper experience
 - provide education as appropriate to campers and other staff
 - administer mini-gluc, and glucagon, provide emergency care
 - give an applicable report to night clinic staff; administer OTC and other medications as ordered
 - Communicate with HCM any issues, needs, or incidents in a timely manner

Other Job Duties:

- Participate in pre-camp clinic training.
- Review camper physicals and paperwork for the assigned group prior to camper arrival.
- Report all incidents and accidents immediately to the Healthcare Manager and Camp Director and cooperate in the completion of required follow-up/documentation.

- Other duties as assigned by the Healthcare Manager, Medical Director, or Camp Director

Qualifications: *(Minimum Education and Experience)*

- Registered nurse (RN) with an active license in the state of Ohio.
- CPR certified.
- First Aid Experience.
- Driver's license.
- Experience in both children and adult illness/injury care.
- Desire to work with children and adolescents.
- Type 1 diabetes experience or CDE preferred.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Ability to lift/assist campers and staff.
- Ability to read and follow directions on medication labels, health forms, physician orders, and parent letters.
- Ability to use a telephone.
- Ability to communicate with parents, staff, and administration about camper health concerns.
- Possess endurance to meet emergency needs.
